Levitin in Riga to discuss transport

Latvian Foreign Minister Edgars Rinkevics (Reform Party), Transport Minister Anrijs Matiss, Latvian President Ugis Uparis and Riga Mayor Nils Usakovs (Harmony Center) had unofficial meetings with the visiting Russian president's aide Igor Levitin last week, TV3 broadcast "Nekas personāls" ("Nothing Personal") reported on Oct. 28.

Levitin arrived in Latvia to take part in the Baltic Forum, organized by Harmony Center leader Janis Urbanovics. He also had an official meeting with President Andris Bērziņš to discuss bilateral relations and cooperation in transport and transit. According to "Nekas personāls," Levitin also met with Matiss and Uparis in a restaurant in Jūrmala, discussing transport and railroads. At the Gallery Park Hotel, Levitin was visited by Usakovs and the officials spoke about the Free-port of Riga, tourism and Latvian product stands Rizhskiy dvorik in Moscow.

The Foreign Ministry invited Levitin to a dinner in Vincents restaurant. Rinkevics told the broadcast that, before the visit, potential times for a meeting were harmonized and it was concluded that a working dinner was the only possibility.

Former Transport Minister Ainārs Šlesers also expressed a desire for a meeting with the Russian president's advisor. He declined to provide any comments to the broadcast.

The broadcast said that Levitin also wanted to meet with Ventspils Mayor Aivars Lembergs (For Latvia and Ventspils). "Nekas personāls," however, did not manage to find out whether the Russian Embassy had been able to organize the meeting. "Nekas personāls" also reported that, according to unofficial information, Patriarch of Moscow and all Russia, Kirill could visit Riga in May 2014. Q
